Global Seminar Location: Serengeti Region of Tanzania




- Based in Arusha, with stays and visits to surrounding areas.
- Site of the largest wildlife migration on earth.








The Safari (Journey, in Kiswahili)

Program fee includes:

- Books
- Personal expenses



Financial Aid and Scholarships

- -Students taking at least 6 credits during the summer can receive FA
- -Summer Pell Grant
- -Residual aid from the academic year can apply to summer

professor or T.A. recommendation, personal
statement, online forms, application fee

Application Review & Interview



Due within one week of acceptance: participant contract & non-refundable deposit



March/April: post acceptance paperwork, pre departure meetings, readings & preparation
